Dear Pledge Managers,

In order to ensure all pledges are properly tabulated and receipted, I am requesting your assistance with the following:

1. Each pledge manager is to collect all pledge envelopes and money from their team members.
2. **ON-LINE PLEDGING** – paddlers have the opportunity to register on line on the Festival's web site for pledge collection.
