Referee	<i>Maintain control of the race. Assessing infractions and penalties. Ensuring safety of all participants. Training and certification required* (*provided by the Lakehead Canoe Club).</i>	Indicate your availability: AM PM All Day
Assistant Referee	<i>Assist referee in duties. Training provided.</i>	
Starter	<i>Control start of race. Training required*.</i>	
Assistant Starter	<i>Assist starter in duties. Training provided.</i>	
Whipper In	<i>Check in teams for each race.</i>	
Chief Marshall	<i>Call teams for each race. Confirms teams available to race.</i>	
Land Marshalls	<i>Assist teams to line up and send to docks.</i>	
Dock Marshalls	<i>Supervise loading and unloading of boats.</i>	
Timers	<i>Responsible for timing race. Training required*.</i>	
Exit & Entrance Gates	<i>Maintains control of entrance and exit to marshalling area</i>	
Runners	<i>Delivers race results to race recorder and announcer</i>	
Steers	<i>Steer boats. Training and certification required*. (Must be available to assist during practices 2 weeks prior to race and on race day).</i>	
Drummers	<i>Sit at the front of boat; provide drumming and other encouragement to teams. Loud voice an asset. Training required*.</i>
